Dear Praying Brethren,

The Lord has heard and answered many of your prayers, and we want to praise Him for all He has done here during these past two months. First, thank you for praying for our health. Aside from some sniffles here and there, we have been feeling much better. In our last letter, I mentioned that my passport needed to be renewed before we could begin our visa renewal application. Just a few days after sending that letter, the new passport arrived! Now, we are working on renewing our visas. Thank you for your faithful prayers!

Thank you also for praying for **Jack and Joy Loveday**, our missionary sponsors. We drove to Madrid at the beginning of April and spent a weekend with them. It was a blessing to meet with their church folks and to thank them in person for helping us get our visas. As mentioned in our previous letter, Bro. Jack is fighting cancer. Your continued prayers for his health are greatly appreciated. With that being said, his last evaluation showed a decrease in certain numbers that indicate the current treatment is working.

We have started an English ministry with the church in Castellar del Valles. We feel profoundly grateful for the church members' support and have been encouraged by the new visitors. We have held two services and plan to hold one each month. The Lord has blessed more ways than we can list here. The most important thing is to see His hand in all the circumstances and to know that this is His will. We are also very grateful to **pastor Moises Campos** for his support and encouragement in this ministry.

In April, my wife and I started talking about purchasing a piano for her to practice at home. I mentioned this to the pastor, who said he had one for us! A brother from the States was ready to move back to the U.S. and had a piano he no longer needed. He offered it to the church free of charge, and, in turn, it was given to us. The way the Lord provides for our needs still amazes me, and while I do not always remember it at the moment, He is sufficient in all things.

The young lady who received Christ a few months ago (we will call her **Ms. O** to protect her privacy) still needs your prayers. It has been a blessing to see her asking questions and growing, but lately, she has been dealing with some difficult circumstances that have made it nearly impossible for her to attend church or spend time with Anna for any discipleship. Only the Lord knows what needs to be done in this situation, and we ask that you pray for His will to be done and that He will give us the wisdom to perform our part.

Thank you for your prayers for Anna's grandfather, **Jack McArdle**. His prognosis is looking better, but he had to have more cancer removed and is currently undergoing radiation treatments. Please keep him in your prayers.

On the language front, Anna and I are both in the intermediate Spanish course. We have also officially started a beginner Catalan course that should have us finished with the first level by November. Please pray that the Lord will strengthen our minds (and loosen our tongues!) as we have more opportunities to minister in Spanish.

We could not be here in Northern Spain without your prayers and support. Thank you so much for thinking of and praying for our family! We pray that the Lord Jesus Christ will reward you in your labor for Him.
