



# PIZZOS TO SPAIN

June – July 2026

Dear Praying Brethren,

We continue to be amazed and humbled by the Lord's care and provision for us. We are also deeply encouraged by your faithful prayers and support.

Many of you have probably heard that the forest fires have been especially severe throughout Spain this year. In July, one broke out only about fifteen minutes from our home, just outside the town where we used to live. We could see the large column of smoke from our patio, and our area was placed under a stay-at-home order for a couple of days. Thankfully, it ended up moving north of us to a mostly unpopulated area, and after about a week, firefighters were able to extinguish it. At the time of writing, some larger, more intense fires are still raging outside of Madrid. Please remember those affected, and especially our brethren there, in your prayers.

**Anna continues to improve and is doing much better than she was several months ago.** Most of her normal abilities have returned, though she still has to limit how much she does. Recently, she was able to participate in our English service for the first time in quite a while but afterward was in considerable pain from being active all day. The nerves remain irritated and can cause significant pain when she overdoes it. Her treatment is now focused on physical therapy rather than injections. Please continue praying for complete healing and for grace and strength during the difficult days.

Toward the end of June, my father, **Tony Pizzo**, went in for a hip replacement, but preoperative testing revealed serious heart-rhythm problems, including ventricular tachycardia. The surgery was canceled, and after further testing he was sent home with medication and a heart monitor. Two weeks later, the monitor detected another event, and he was told to go to the ER immediately. Doctors performed a cardiac ablation, during which his heart had to be restarted three times. The Lord was very merciful, and his heart is otherwise healthy and free of blockages. He is now home resting and recovering. **Please pray that the procedure corrected the source of the arrhythmia and that the Lord will grant him a full recovery.**

On the ministry front, **the church celebrated its ninth anniversary.** Although we have not been with the church from its beginning, it was a blessing to look back and rejoice in all that the Lord has done over the years. We are grateful for the privilege of serving alongside this church family and having a part in what God is doing here.

**We would also appreciate your prayers for Bro. Joe**, whom we have mentioned in previous letters and who has faithfully served alongside us in the ministry. He has been dealing with some health issues recently, and we ask that you pray for the Lord to give him strength, grace, and improved health.

Recently, we were able to have updated family photos taken and, Lord willing, **will soon have a new prayer card available.** Anyone interested in receiving physical copies may contact us with a mailing address and the number desired, and we will do our best to send them out as soon as they are ready.
