Dear Praying Brethren,

We trust and pray that this letter finds you and yours doing well in your work for the Lord. We hope you will excuse the delay in getting this letter out. The past few months have been a wild ride for us and, I have waited to send it until some things settled and I had something concrete to report. Most of you will, no doubt, be interested in the status of our visas. It has taken longer than expected to get some definitive answers with some doors closing and others opening.

In our last letter, we stated that although we had a church in Spain that was going to be our sponsor, they were hindered in getting their part of the sponsorship complete. This hindrance has turned into a closed door with this church no longer able to fulfill the role of our sponsor in Spain. With this door closed, we were back to square one in getting a visa for Spain. There is no denying that the news was discouraging but, through it all, the Lord's hand was evident in the circumstances and, we believe that it is in no small part due to the prayers of the saints. Within a week of getting the news, we were able to contact a veteran missionary in Spain that is optimistic about being able to help us get our visas. He has been on the field for thirty-nine years and has ample experience in sponsoring missionaries into the country. There is some additional paperwork that he needs to attend to before starting on our sponsorship letter but, Lord willing, this will be the new path forward for getting into Spain. We should know more after the new year and, we earnestly covet your continued prayers on this front.

As for our time these past three months, most of it has been spent staying busy in various ministries of our home church. The Lord has opened several doors to minister here in Pensacola and the time to contribute and be spiritually fed has been a great help to our family. As discouraging as it has been to have to wait without answers about our visas, it truly has been good to have a part of the ministry here. The time spent with both our church family and physical family is an added blessing that we have tried not to take for granted.

I would like to take a moment and give some glory to the Lord for an answered personal prayer ours. Since coming off the road from full-time deputation, we have not had a stable place to live in Pensacola. As I am sure many people are dealing with the decreased availability of housing and the increased price of what is open, we too have felt the pressure of finding affordable and stable lodging. In the past year, not counting our time on the road, we have moved four times. This has been big stress and burden on our whole family and, while the Lord has been more than faithful in giving us comfortable places to stay, having to move every few months has been exhausting. Thankfully, the Lord has provided a place for us where, Lord willing, we will stay until we move to the field. The timing and order of events and circumstances was all the Lord's hand and, we just want to take a moment to thank Him publicly for answering a prayer that was not a necessity but really meant a lot to us.

Thank you all so much for your continued prayers and support. It has been especially obvious that, over the past few months, you have been praying for us. Thank you and, may the Lord continue to bless and guide you in your service for Him.
