Dear Praying Brethren,

Let me begin this letter by apologizing for not sending it sooner. Normally, we send one out every two months. This time there was a lot of uncertainty concerning our visas and, I wanted to have some more information about it before sending our letter out.

After a lot of hard work and waiting, we have received the last of the U.S. documents necessary for our visa application. Unfortunately, due to several factors in Spain, our sponsoring church has been hindered in getting the papers needed for their part in the sponsorship process. Lord willing, this will change in the coming weeks but, please pray for the pastor and his church as they attempt to get their paperwork submitted in Spain.

Towards the end of May, I found out that our visa application would most likely be denied if I did not submit ordination papers with the sponsorship request. Thankfully, my pastor, on short notice, was able to set up a time for my ordination and, on Sunday, June 13th, I was officially ordained to the ministry. Having my pastor and church leadership publicly lay hands on me and pray for our family as we get ready to take this next step in our ministry was truly a humbling experience. After a brief doctrinal examination, my former youth pastor and now assistant pastor of Bible Baptist Church, Bro. Colvin, gave a solemn and Biblical charge on our responsibilities in the ministry and reminded us that **“unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required”**. Overall, it was a blessing and encouragement to see the outpouring of love and support from our church and, we could not ask for better people to be behind us as we strive to get the gospel to the people of Spain.

The past few months have been filled with a lot of spiritual attacks and trials. By the very nature of these circumstances, I cannot give the details in a prayer letter but suffice it to say, as difficult as certain circumstances have been, our Father has been more than gracious. We do ask that you continue to lift us up before the Lord.

In closing, I ask that you pray for a Roman Catholic man by the name of **JC** who, in his own words is, “not your usual Catholic.” I had the chance to speak with him at length and, during our conversation, he told me that he had just found out that after nearly ten years of fighting a rare and aggressive cancer, he was now cancer-free. Given the subject matter and how open and frank he was to speak about life and death, the conversation easily flowed into spiritual matters. Although he was given a clear presentation of the gospel, I do not believe he was ready to accept Christ on the spot. Please pray that the Lord will work in his heart and that he will get saved.

We want to thank each of you for all your prayers and support over the past couple of months. While all the glory goes to the Lord Jesus Christ for any blessings we have, there is no doubt that without the generous and sacrificial giving of many of you, we could not fulfill our calling. So, please accept from the bottom of our hearts our gratitude for your faithful giving.
