Dear Praying Brethren,

These past few months have been among the more challenging we have had in a while, but they have also been full of the Lord's blessings and provision. We remain abundantly grateful for your faithfulness in upholding our family and ministry before the Lord.

During most of March and April, Anna was nearly bedridden. Thankfully, toward the end of this period, she began to regain some mobility, though she has continued to deal with significant pain. After seeing several doctors and specialists, we are now working with a pain specialist and a physical therapist who specializes in the pelvic muscles.

It appears the original diagnosis of adductor tendonitis was correct, but as it began to heal, the surrounding muscles tightened and irritated the nerves, creating a painful cycle of nerve irritation and muscle tension. The current treatment involves targeted injections to identify the irritated nerves. Once located, the next step would likely be a radiofrequency treatment to calm them long enough for physical therapy to be more effective. This has been a slow and painful process, but Anna has been a real trooper. **Please continue praying for wisdom for the doctors, strength for Anna, and a full recovery.**

One of the clearest ways the Lord provided during this time was through **Emily**, a young lady from the States whom Anna used to babysit in Miami. Through circumstances clearly ordered by the Lord, she was able to come help us for a month. When she arrived, Anna was at her worst and hardly able to get out of bed. Emily's help allowed me to take care of necessary responsibilities while giving Anna the ability to rest. She was a tremendous help to our family, and we are very thankful for her willingness to come and minister to us.

We celebrated the English ministry's third anniversary in April. Though we were a smaller group than in previous years, it was still a sweet time of fellowship and a good reminder of the Lord's faithfulness.

For Sant Jordi, one of the major spring holidays here in Catalonia, we were able once again to set up a booth. Since towns hold market festivals where people sell books and roses, our church sets up a booth to give away tracts, New Testaments, and Bibles. A number of people stopped for longer conversations, and we ask that you would pray that the seeds sown would bear fruit.

Andrés and I continue with preaching classes. Helping to equip a young man for potential ministry is not a responsibility I take lightly, but it has been a great joy and a source of encouragement.

On the family side, **Catalina had her 10th birthday and Justus his 6th!** It is still difficult to believe how much they have grown, but we are so grateful to the Lord for His blessings on our family. **Anamelia's visa appeal is still pending.** Because of recent changes to the law, our lawyer is hopeful her case may still be considered favorably. Please pray that the Lord would allow her visa to finally be approved.
